- 1. All CTF Tournament and Playing Rules will be strictly enforced. To be eligible for participation in the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association Championship Tournament all bowlers must be CTF members of a Local Association in the Province of Ontario, which are under the jurisdiction of the Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association. Non-residents must hold Local Association cards by January 1, 2014 and have a current Ontario average. Youth bowlers participating in Youth Leagues will not be permitted to bowl in this tournament
- Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference between the bowler's highest average and 240. 2. The following averages will be acceptable:
 - The bowler's highest 2012-13 yearbook average (CTF or USBC), minimum of 21 games. (A)

(B) If the bowler does not have a valid average under (A), the bowler will use their highest sanctioned 2013-2014 winter league average for a minimum of 21 games as of January 1, 2014.

- (C) Bowlers who do not have a valid average under (A) or (B) must use their highest 2013 sanctioned summer league based on 21 or more games.
- Bowlers who do not have a valid average under (A), (B) or (C) must use their highest (D) sanctioned league average as of the first day of the tournament, minimum of 21 games.
- (E) Eligible bowlers who do not have an acceptable average as outlined above will bowl scratch. If you are using an average other than (A) above, please indicate on your entry form.
- 3. Team captains will be notified by email/mail of acceptance of entry on an entry confirmation form that will include time and date of bowling for all team members. To aid in verifying January 1, 2014 averages, the Tournament Director will send an average verification form to be filled out and signed by the League Secretary. This form is to be returned as soon as possible. Hotel costs, locations and phone numbers will be provided with each confirmation.
- 4. Bowlers may enter teams, doubles and singles as many times as they desire. Bowlers in more than one Team event must change at least 2 members of the team. Bowlers in more than one Doubles event must bowl with a different partner each time. Bowlers can cash in each team and doubles event they enter but only once in singles. The first series bowled in each event will count in the All Events total.

For Mixed Division: A team must consist of at least 1 of each gender, a doubles entry must be 1 female and 1 male. The singles portion of the event will be counted in the respective Women's or Men's portion of their respective Provincial Championship Tournament.

- Teams consist of four eligible bowlers. Bowlers entering Doubles and Singles will bowl both events with the Doubles 5. bowled first, followed by the Singles. Each event will be scheduled on a pair of lanes.
- 6. ENTRY CLOSING DATE IS MIDNIGHT APRIL 20, 2014 Entries must be delivered in person to the Tournament Director, or post marked prior to midnight of this date. No registered mail or courier packages.
- Teams and Individuals may cash in both Scratch and Handicap Divisions for the same Entry if optional Scratch fee has 7. been paid.
- 8. In the case of a lst place tie in any event, co-champions will be declared and duplicate prizes will be awarded.
- 9. Bowlers who are unmarried. Grade or High School Students and are under the age of 18 as of the date of participation in the tournament must submit a CTF Parental Consent Form at least 1 week prior to competing in the Tournament unless accompanied by a parent or quardian, in which case forms may be submitted at the time of bowling.
- 10. Use of any foreign substance such as talcum powder or moistening of shoes will not be permitted (CTF Rule 12). Each bowler is allowed 1 bowling ball on the ball rack.
- 11. Scratch Events are available in Team, Doubles, Singles and Combine (total of scratch doubles and singles). \$10.00 per person per event (optional). In teams and doubles events, all individuals must pay the \$10.00 optional fee.
- 12. CTF Rule 319A(2) pertaining to the 10 pin improvement rule does apply for this Tournament. Bowlers must bring their league final average sheets with them at time of check-in.
- 13. Any bowler who qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more (cash or merchandise) in any tournament for the previous 12 months must report his actual score for possible re-rating. (CTF Rule 319d & 319e)
- 14. ALL PRIZE MONEY RETURNED 100%. Minimum prize ratio is 1 in 8 in each event.
- 15 TOURNAMENT HANDICAP WINNERS WILL RECEIVE CHAMPIONSHIP PLAQUES IN ADDITION TO ANY MONETARY AWARD.
- 16. Proper Dress Required: No Cut-off pants or sweat pants, hats, short shorts, tank tops or midriff-showing shirts.
- 17. FULL FEES MUST BE SENT WITH ENTRY FORM ---NO POST-DATED CHEQUES AND NO PARTIAL FEES WILL BE ACCEPTED. There will be no refund of entry fees (CTF Rule 316) - NSF cheques will be charged \$30.00.
- 18. Please make cheques payable to: Ontario Tenpin Bowling Association.
- 19. The Tournament Director's decisions in all matters pertaining to the tournament are final.
