TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is Sanctioned by the Canadian Tenpin Federation. All CTF Tournament and Playing Rules will be strictly enforced. To be eligible for participation in Hamilton & District tournaments all bowlers must be current CTF registered participants.
2. There will be 4 different divisions. Bantam, Prep, Junior and Intermediate. The different categories will be: Mother/Daughter, Mother/Son, Father/Daughter, Father/Son.
Note: Adult bowler does not need to be related to the bowler.
3. Bowlers (Youth & Adult) will use Highest Yearbook Average from 2022/2023 or if no Yearbook Average is available, please use highest average as of January 6, 2024 (minimum 9 games). **Bowlers using current averages will need a current standing sheet to accompany the entries.** If no yearbook or current average the bowler will bowl scratch. If Adult bowler does not have an established sanctioned average then all Women will enter using 120 and all Men will enter using 150. **Tournament Director reserves the right to rerate any bowler at any time.**
4. Lane oiling pattern will be the Standard House shot.
5. Each entry will receive handicap based on 100% of the difference between their team average and 420.
6. A champion will be declared in each division and **in the case of a tie, there will be a 1 game roll-off at the conclusion of the tournament.**
7. The format consists of three (3) games of bowling by each Bowler and each Adult.
8. Awards are based on a ratio of 1 in 5. Winners in each division will be awarded a Scholarship Prize that will be determined by the number of entries. All prize monies will be returned.
9. Entrants MUST register 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad time.
10. Participation will be OPEN to ALL sanctioned CTF Youth Bowlers that have registered for the 2023/2024 season. All bowlers not sanctioned through Hamilton & District will be required to pay \$5 for participation.
11. Proper dress code is required. Any attire worn that is not suitable will result in disqualification of the bowler from the tournament. Examples of prohibited attire include but not limited to: hats, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops and short skirts.
12. Only bowlers and officials are allowed in the bowler's area.
13. No refunds will be issued unless the tournament is cancelled.
14. No eating or alcohol consumption is allowed by all bowlers. Non-alcoholic drinks are allowed in designated areas.
15. The Tournament Director's decision in all matters pertaining to the tournament are final.
