## TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All CTF rules will be strictly enforced.
2. Bowlers will use highest yearbook average from 2018/19 season or if no yearbook average available will use highest average as of October 27, 2019 (min. 9 games). **Bowlers using current averages need a current standing sheet to accompany the entries.** If no yearbook or current average the bowler will bowl scratch. League Coaches are responsible for CTF memberships and averages. The Tournament Director will resolve any uncertainty with regards to this rule.
3. Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference between bowler's average and 210. Averages exceeding 210 will bowl scratch.
4. The format consists of four (4) games of no-tap bowling, dropping the lowest score of the four (4) games bowled plus your handicap will give you your final total. **If there is a tie there will be a 1 game roll-off at the finish of tournament.**
5. Awards are based on a ratio of 1 in 8 or the greater portion thereof. 1<sup>st</sup> Place winners in each division will be awarded a Scholarship Prize.
6. Entrants must register 30 minutes prior to squad time.
7. Proper dress code is required. Any attire worn that is not suitable (League Shirts are recommended) will result in disqualification of the bowler from the tournament. The Tournament Director will be responsible for final decisions regarding the dress code.
8. No refunds or bowler substitutions are allowed.
9. Only bowlers and officials are allowed in the bowlers areas.
10. No alcohol is allowed to be consumed by the bowlers. Eating and Non-alcoholic drinks are allowed in designated areas.
11. Any disputes over rules not covered above will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
12. Make cheques payable to Hamilton & District Tenpin Bowling Association (HDTBA). There will be a \$75.00 charge for NSF cheques.
