RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All posted and CTF rules will be strictly enforced.
2. Teams will consist of four (4) members. All teams and doubles may be mixed. (Boys and Girls).
3. Each division will bowl three (3) games.
4. Handicap based on 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 210.
5. Open to all boys and girls who have paid registration fees through the Hamilton & District Tenpin Bowling Association.
6. Each entrant will use his/her highest CTF league average as of March 29/20 based on a minimum of nine (9) games by this date. ALL OTHERS MUST BOWL SCRATCH.
7. Entries must be postmarked no later than APRIL 4, 2020. No entry will be accepted without accompanying entry fee. No refunds will be given.
8. League Coach is responsible for verification of CTF membership and averages. Falsification of average will result in the disqualification of the bowler and/or team. A copy of the averages must be included with the entry. Failure to include a league standing sheet will result in the entry being returned.
9. All entrants must report at least thirty (30) minutes before assigned squad times. Changes and/or Substitutes must report one (1) hour before assigned squad times.
10. Bowlers may enter doubles more than once as long as they change their doubles partner. Bowlers may enter teams more than once as long as at least two of the team members are changed from the original team.
11. Awards will be awarded based on a 1 in 8 ratios or greater part thereof. 1st Place winner in each Division will be awarded a scholarship prize. **In a case of a tie for 1st Co-Champions will be declared.**
12. Each entrant may enter one or all of the teams; doubles or singles events.
13. There will be NO drinking of alcohol products by bowlers. Eating & Non-Alcoholic drinks are allowed in designated areas.
14. DRESS CODE: Proper attire is required (League Shirts are recommended) or the bowlers (he/she) will not be allowed to bowl as per the discretion of the Tournament Director.
15. Only bowlers and those instructed by the tournament director are allowed in the bowling area. There will be no coaching in the bowler's area.
16. Appeals or protests regarding scores or eligibility shall be made in writing to the Tournament Director within seventy-two (72) hours after the occurrence.
17. Tardy bowlers will start in the frame he/she arrives in.
18. All rules not covered will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
19. Make Cheques payable to Hamilton & District Tenpin Bowling Association (HDTBA). There will be a \$75.00 charge for NSF Cheques.
